Friday, July 29, 2022

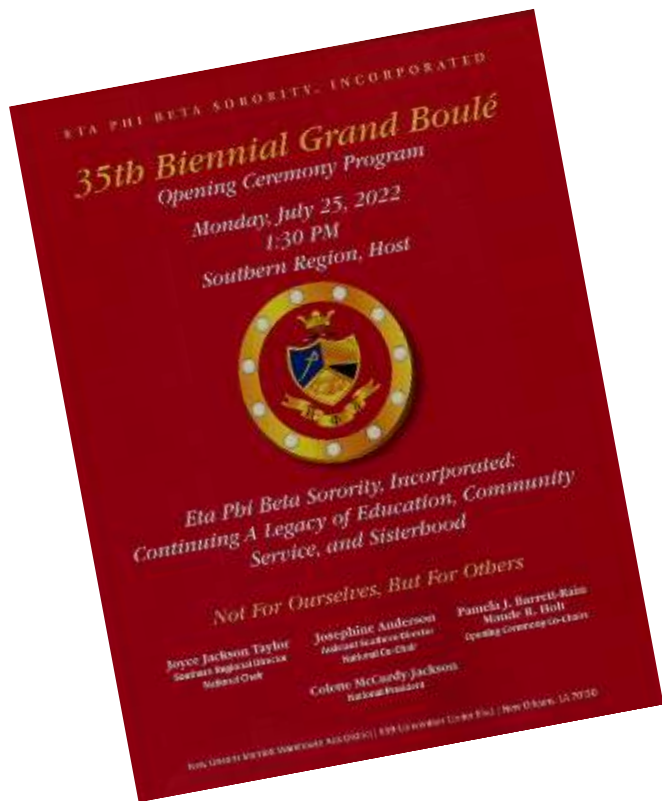
- Merits and Awards Breakfast
