Use of QR Code for CDC Bridge Access Program

Effective immediately, all collateral materials for Good Health WINs must include the QR Code for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Bridge Access Program. This includes all flyers, brochures, bags, posters, labels or any other GHWs collateral materials.

CDC's Bridge Access Program provides free COVID-19 vaccines to adults without health insurance and adults whose insurance does not cover all COVID-19 vaccine costs. Use of the code on our collateral materials will direct individuals to the Bridge Access Program website and help them find a location for free COVID-19 vaccinations.

Below is the CDC Bridge Access Program QR code. You can also go to the Bridge Access Program website at <u>Bridge Access Program | CDC</u> and right-click on the webpage and create a QR Code for the webpage.



By visiting the website, individuals will understand that they can get free COVID-19 vaccines at healthcare providers, federally supported health centers, and pharmacies (CVS, Walgreens, and eTrueNorth) participating in the Bridge Access Program. They can also visit vaccines.gov to find providers that offer free COVID-19 vaccines through the Bridge Access Program. Providers participating in the Bridge Access Program are contractually obligated to add vaccine availability to vaccines.gov.
